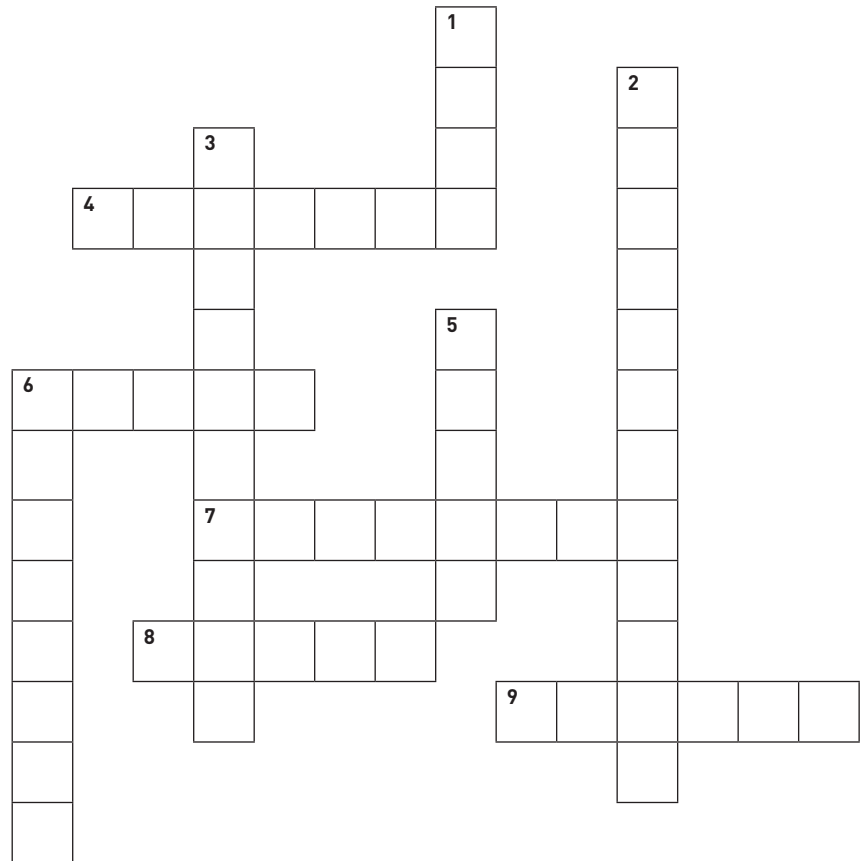


# ORCHARD CROSSWORD

## Down

- 1 An oval fleshy fruit which can range from a deep blueish purple through to a light pinky yellow colour when ripe and contains a flattish pointed stone.
- 2 These berries grow wild everywhere and tend to grow in a tangle of climbing branches.
- 3 A round edible yellowish-green berry with a thin translucent hairy skin.
- 5 A very popular orchard fruit, with many varieties for both eating and cooking available.
- 6 Birds love these fruits, so the longer they stay on the bush, the smaller your harvest might be!



## Across

- 4 A flower or a mass of flowers, found on a fruit tree or bush.
- 6 A drink made from fermented apple juice.
- 7 A fruit tree whose branches are trained to grow flat against a wall, supported on a lattice.
- 8 The sweet product of a tree that contains seed and can be eaten as food.
- 9 This fruit grows in both sweet and sour varieties. The sweet ones can be eaten straight from the tree but the sour ones are better cooked and make delicious jams.
